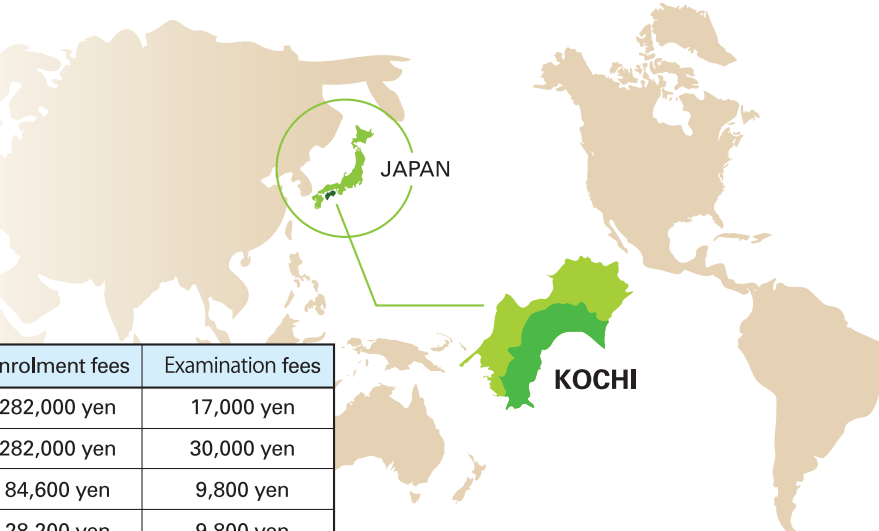

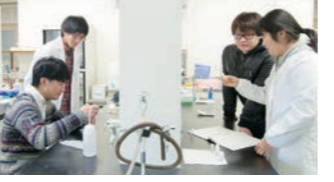

Faculty of Science and Technology

The faculty's goal is to meld science education that stresses logical thinking and engineering education that stresses actual use. We educate students so that they can make decisions based on science regarding the various problems society faces.
