Since there is no dormitory for international students around Asakura campus, most of the international students live in apartments, most ranging in cost from 33,000 yen to 50,000 yen per month. Initial costs such as refundable deposit, key money and agency commission may apply (equivalent to three or four months' rent).

In order to rent an apartment, you need a guarantor. However, Kochi University does not provide an institutional guarantee service. Students who cannot find a guarantor are advised to use a guarantee company appointed by their real estate agency. We recommend a guarantee company called GTN, but it is the landlord/agency that decides to choose the service or not.

<b>Health Insurance</b>	
	<p>Exchange students must join Japan's National Health Insurance System and On-campus Accident Insurance after arrival. However, those will not cover all expenses. We strongly recommend that you purchase insurance to cover you for medical expenses, personal accident, personal baggage, money and public liability.</p>
<b>Immigration Service</b>	
	<p>Students must obtain Student VISA. After the exchange application was accepted (around July or January), we will send CERTIFICATE OF ELIGIBILITY and Letter of Acceptance via mail. Students will apply for the VISA to Japanese Embassy or Consulate General with those documents.</p>
